HARRISONBURG, VA (June 12, 2018) – Harrisonburg Downtown Renaissance (HDR) has big plans for this year's Valley Fourth in downtown Harrisonburg, including a variety of family-friendly activities for all interests and ages. Whether you are ready to break a sweat at VA Momentum's Valley 4th RUN or Breathe Pilates and Fitness' Sunrise Circuit, test your limits on the climbing wall, or dance the night away with exceptional local bands and a beer in hand. Valley Fourth will feature kids' activities, including eating contests and cake walks, Friendly City Food Co-op's Watermelon Seed Spitting contest, art activities with Shenandoah Valley Art Mobile, bubbles, balloon animals, bounce houses and more. Of course, Valley Fourth will conclude with another bigger, better fireworks display.

"The location offers the community more viewing options, and gives us the ability to reschedule the show in case of inclement weather."
